


# Novartis Rooombooking Case Study


#### Client:





We were asked to assist Novartis with a short Tutorialseries on how to book meeting rooms, auditoria and specialty rooms correctly. The new automated booking system generates requests on the backend and integrates with multiple calendars.

## Preparations



From the scripting (the requirement was to sound informal and helpful) to a sketched storyboard and the actual filming and editing, we provided the entire project management as well as the execution for Novartis.

The challenge was to shoot in a live office environment and keep the crew small and agile, so we were able to shoot multiple episodes in one day. So we limited ourselves to Camera, Audio, Lighting and Makeup. To keep the costs low, we casted all characters within the staff, from background people up the the main lead.



# Shooting

The challenge the team faced later on in postproduction was to get the perfect stitch so the stitch lines would not be noticed when watched in VR and to stabilize the swinging of the camera while flying with such a heavy lift.









## Production

Due to the restricted information on some videos, we are only able to show the first one to the public.



We decided to use Mistika VR to stitch and balance the footage off camera to make it seamless and then went into Davinci Resolve for a detailed color grading and the final look and feel of the flight.
